
Persona: The mask we wear, including the roles we take on that are not authentic to our psyches, or the faces we hide from the public while we play out our roles










Closing Argument(!): We can draw on the power and the light of our stars. They are lodestars, guiding stars, star maps, maps of our psyche, our particular and peculiar constellation.
